Admissions Consultation for Embrace Multi Academy Trust Schools

In accordance with School Admissions Code 2021, admissions authorities are required to consult on its admissions arrangements whenever changes are proposed, and at least once every seven years. Embrace Multi Academy Trust is consulting on the proposed admissions policies 2027-28 onwards for all of its schools:

- Arnesby CE Primary School
- Brockington College
- Croft CE Primary School
- Huncote Primary School
- Manorfield CE Primary School
- Rawlins
- Sherrier CE Primary School
- St Peter's CE Primary School (Market Bosworth)
- St Peter's CE Primary School (Whetstone)
- Swinford CE Primary School

The consultation will run from 19 December 2025 to 31 January 2026. During this time, we welcome the views of parents and other key stakeholders about the proposed changes which are summarised below.

1. All Schools in Embrace Multi Academy Trust

<u>Proposal</u>: To change the wording of the last oversubscription criterion from 'all other children' to 'children who live nearest the school', to make it clearer and easier to understand. This proposal applies to the admissions policies of all the schools listed above.

2. St Peter's Church of England Primary School (Market Bosworth)

<u>Proposal 1</u>: To reduce the school's PAN for entry into Reception from 36 pupils to 30 pupils. Infant Class Sizes Regulations limit the usual number of children in an infant class (Reception, Year 1 and Year 2) to 30 per qualified teacher. Reducing the PAN will ensure compliance with the regulations and allow more efficient budget planning to maintain high standards of teaching and learning. If adopted, this change will apply to the 2027 Reception intake and each subsequent Reception intake; classes already at the school will not be affected.

Proposal 2:

- To add two new items of oversubscription criteria:
 - Criterion 2: A combined criterion of 'living in catchment' **and** 'having an older brother or sister at the school'.
 - Criterion 6: 'Children of a member of staff employed to work at St Peter's CE Primary School'

- To amend the wording of:
 - Criterion 4: from 'having an older brother or sister at the school at the point of application' to 'having an older brother or sister at the school at the point of admission'

This proposal will bring the oversubscription criteria in line with other primary schools' admissions policies within Embrace Multi Academy Trust.

3. Brockington College

Proposal: To add New Lubbesthorpe Primary School to the list of feeder schools named in the policy and referred to in oversubscription criteria 2, 4 & 8. This proposal reflects that New Lubbesthorpe Primary School has reached the point of having a Year 6 cohort, having opened as a new school in September 2019.

4. Rawlins - Sixth Form

Proposal: To change the PAN from 240 (internal and external students combined) to 60 (external applicants only). Admissions authorities must set a PAN for entry into Year 12 for external applicants only. All eligible internal students in Year 11 at Rawlins who wish to enter Year 12 will continue to do so; there is no change to this arrangement.

This proposal will make it clearer that a minimum of 60 places will be allocated to eligible external applicants, in addition to any places allocated for eligible internal students at Rawlins. Depending on the demand for places each year, it may be possible to admit further external applicants above the PAN until capacity limits are reached.
